## Kingswood

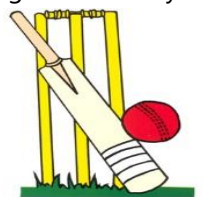

## Vacancy

We have a vacancy for a cleaner (temporary contract in the first instance) at school to work alongside our existing cleaner. Main duties will include opening school, cleaning classrooms, toilets and the main building, doing periodic safety checks and helping to keep the school grounds tidy. Training will be given. The role is paid at point 7 (£7.83 p/h) and will be 10 hours per week in the morning (either 6am – 8am or 7am – 9am). Please be aware that there will be a requirement during school close downs, such as half term/Easter/ summer holidays, where the normal working pattern will have to be amended to meet the requirements of the school. Ask at the office if you have any questions or would like an application form. Closing date is 26<sup>th</sup> January.

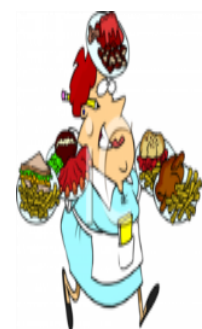
