#### Admissions for Year 7

The results for secondary school applications made during 2018-19 admissions round were sent to parents earlier this month. To our surprise 3 children were allocated a place at a school that was not their first choice (Woldgate). It would appear that this was an administrative error and thankfully places have since been secured in accordance with Woldgate's Admission Policy. Melbourne Primary attracts many families out of catchment and so for clarity and peace of mind here is the criteria applied:

If the number of applicants is greater than the number of places available, priority will then be given according to the following criteria:

- 1. Children who have a sibling\* attending the school in Years 7 to 10. (\*Siblings are defined as brothers or sisters living in the same house, as their primary place of residence, including half- and step-brothers or sisters)
- 2. Children who have attended a school that is part of the Wolds Learning Partnership, since the beginning of National Curriculum Year 3.
- 3. Children who have attended the school's named feeder junior or primary schools since the beginning of National Curriculum Year 3.
- 4. Children of members of staff who have been in post for two years at Woldgate School and Sixth Form College.
- 5. Children who live closest to the school. The distance from the child's home to the school main entrance on Kilnwick Road, as measured by the school. Priority will be given to those living nearest to the school. (Feeder Primaries (Schools whose pupils have applied to and will attend Woldgate School in September 2020). Barmby Moor, Bishop Wilton, Bubwith, Bugthorpe, Holme on Spalding Moor, Melbourne (Part of the Wolds Learning Partnership, Mount Pleasant, Pocklington Junior School (Part of the Wolds Learning Partnership), Sledmere, St Martin's, Fangfoss, St Mary's and St Joseph's, St Mary's (Market Weighton), Stamford Bridge (Part of the Wolds Learning Partnership), Sutton on Derwent, Warter, Wetwang and Wilberfoss.
