Did you know that if you receive any of the benefits below, your child could be eligible for pupil premium funding?

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided they're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on which is paid for 4 weeks after no longer qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit

Please register if this applies to you as the school will receive £1,320 per annum towards their education. It may also entitle your child to Free School Meals once they move to year 3.
